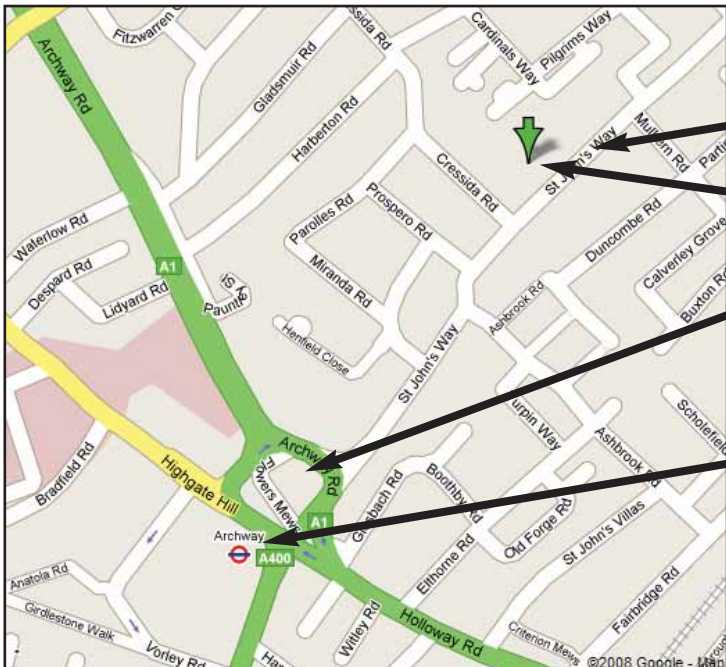


## DIRECTIONS FROM M1 MOTORWAY

Leave the M1 at Junction 2  
Then merge into the A1 (signposted to Central London and The City)  
At the traffic lights continue forward  
At Henley's Corner go onto A 406 and keep in the right lanes  
Branch right to the A1 signposted (Central London, Holloway, Highgate)  
Bear right (one way) to Archway Road  
Continue forward (signposted Central London, Holloway, Archway)  
At "The Woodman" public house continue forward A1  
At Archway Junction turn left into St. John's Way
