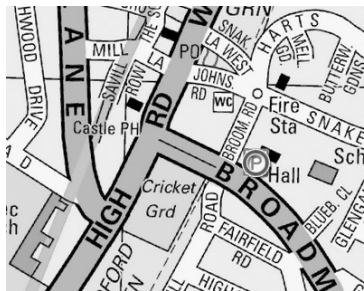
The campaign was formed at the end of last October at a massive public meeting in Woodford, followed by another successful meeting in Walthamstow the following week. Since then we have held meetings, and a big demonstration in February.

Our members are nurses, doctors, consultants, health workers, patients, and members of the general public. Members come from all sections of the community and across the political spectrum, united by the common cause. We do not and will not promote any particular political party or organisation.

The current crisis began to hit in May last year, and local campaigns began at once with organisations such as Save Our Health Services and Keep Our NHS Public. Community nurses were among the first to get into action as they faced devastating cuts.

We can make a difference! Our strong and united voice has had a major impact in highlighting the importance of Whipps to the community.

Local newspapers have added their own weight to the fight as have MPs councillors and many community and health service user groups. Tens of thousands have signed petitions calling for Whipps to stay.
